Chairman's Report: 2020/2021;

ECC's year commenced with the sad loss of Cllr Henry Anderson, Chairman commented *"that it is good again to be able to convene following covid, in a building that he contributed so much too"*.

For the past 18 months ECC have continued to meet virtually and convene meetings on a monthly basis. Agendas have been full with big items in relation to Health, Infrastructure (Active Travel Path, Flooding, Roads/Traffic) and Planning.

Local Councillors representing the ward have highlighted issues and with the aid of local PKC Councillors many of the matters being resolved or directed accordingly to the correct resource to resolve matters arising. An example of this is the installation of a new path being constructed presently on the eastern approach from Forgan Grove to Forgandenny village itself.

J Bruce, Chairman thanked his fellow councillors in their voluntary role for all their endeavours over the past year and assistance in the larger community project work undertaken by ECC and also that of their own local communities.

Secretary's Report:

The past 12 months have been busy as commented by the Chairman in his report.

Earn ward has benefitted from RWE Lochelbank Windfarm community fund in supporting our local halls financially during the pandemic and now good to see them reopen and ready to welcome our community groups back. The Covid Relief Fund from RWE Lochelbank, will aid community groups restarting and will hopefully help on the way to recovery for local groups across both the Earn and Glenfarg Wards.
