i	<p>Forteviot</p> <p>1. SCOTTISH YOUTH CYCLE RACE - the race held in Forteviot on Saturday 2nd April was a great success. However, concern was raised in the village about the unscheduled practice, late afternoon, the previous day. This involved a large number of cyclists when no temporary traffic restrictions were in place & the B935 was already v.busy with traffic including lorries & buses. AML contacted Scottish Cycling & in response, they indicated that the situation on the Friday should not have occurred. They wished to assure the Forteviot community that for future races, cyclists will be properly briefed in advance about following the rules of the road when having practices. Scottish Cycling also expressed their gratitude to the Forteviot community for the opportunity to host the race once again in the village.</p> <p>2. FORTHCOMING ROADWORKS - in response to having contacted PKC Traffic & Network Communities re the roadworks on the B935 (Forgandenny) & B912 (Necessity Brae) scheduled for May 2022, clarification was received that these would not overlap as had previously appeared to be the case. Instead, the roadworks would run consecutively & both roads would be open to traffic outwith working hours.</p> <p>3.
