- **V** Brunt Hill Wind Farm Scoping opinion for proposed Section 36 Application. A M Losty attended Pre Application Consultation held in Dunning. AML notes following the meeting;
 - Company concerned is E Power Ltd. based in Dunfermline.
 - Initially, there were to be 26 turbines erected but no. has now been reduced to 19. Each will have a tip height (sweep) of 200/220m.
 - Depending on where you live in Dunning, turbines may be visible.
 - Recent Govt. legislation on increasing green energy targets means that previous wind farm applications earlier refused, can now be reconsidered.
 - E Power hopes to make application to PKC for Brunt Hill between Sept. & Nov. of this year. Wind farm to become operational in 2028/29.
 - An annual community benefit estimated at £684 000 will be made for the life of the wind farm once it is completed.
 - E Power willing to make presentations to community groups 15/20 mins.
 plus questions. Alternatively, a PDF presentation can be requested for viewing
 - There will be a new link road made to connect the wind farm to the M9
