The order will temporarily prohibit parking and loading (both sides) on Side Street, Bridge of Earn from its junction with Back Street (313266, 718276) to its junction with the A912 Main Street (313178, 718249), a distance of 90 metres or thereby. Pedestrian & emergency vehicular access to premises will be maintained.
